Child Protection Policy

The Henley Drama Festival is concerned about the welfare and safety of all its participants and in particular that of children and will therefore, do everything possible to create an ethos in which children feel secure.

The Henley Drama Festival expects groups to provide CRB checked chaperones for all children aged 16 or under, who are taking part in the Festival. A current licence must be provided as proof of this, which should be seen by the Festival Stage Manager in good time before the children can perform.

The Henley Drama Festival will ensure as far as possible that the children are given separate changing rooms.

Where children under the age of 16 are involved, all entrants are obliged to comply with all legislation appertaining to "The Children and Young Persons Act 1963", "The Child (Performances) Regulation 1968", "The Protection of Children Act 1999" and the "Criminal Justice and Services Act 2000". (See Rule 3 of Rules of Entry)
